#### INSTITUTIONAL INITIATIVES:

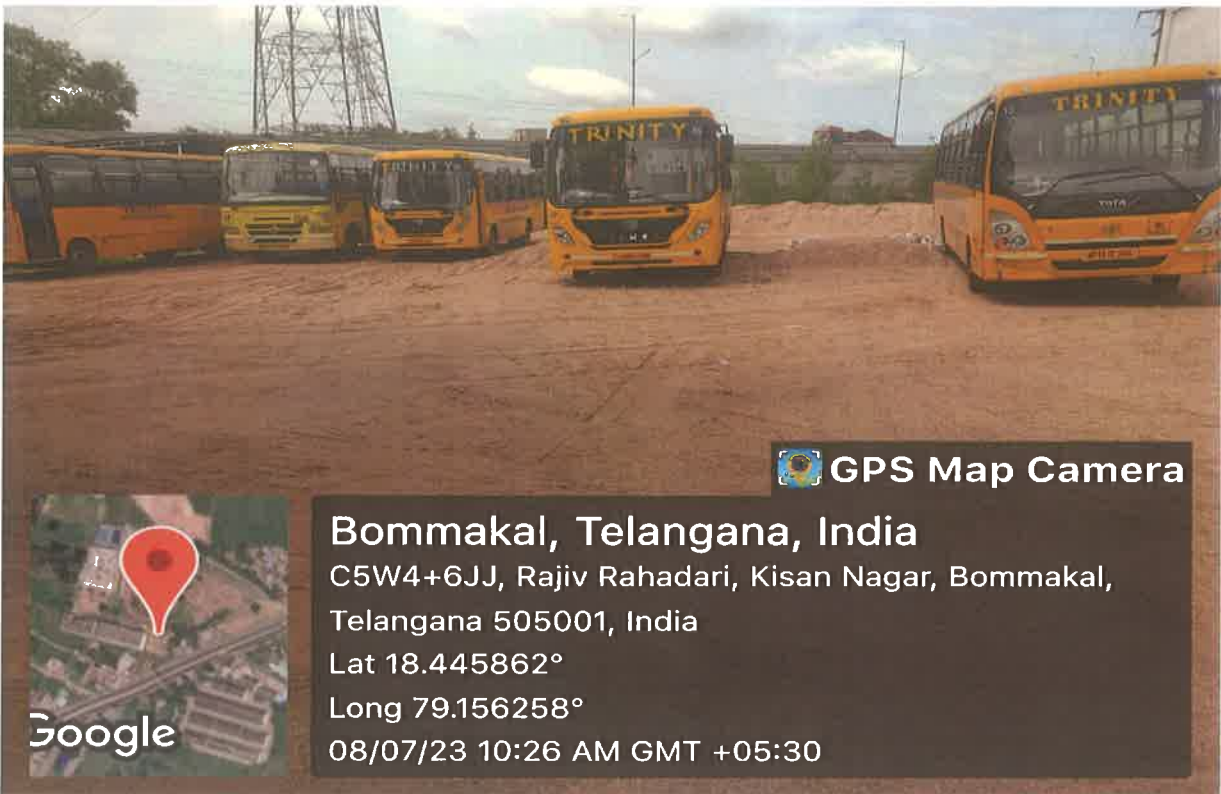



 GPS Map Camera

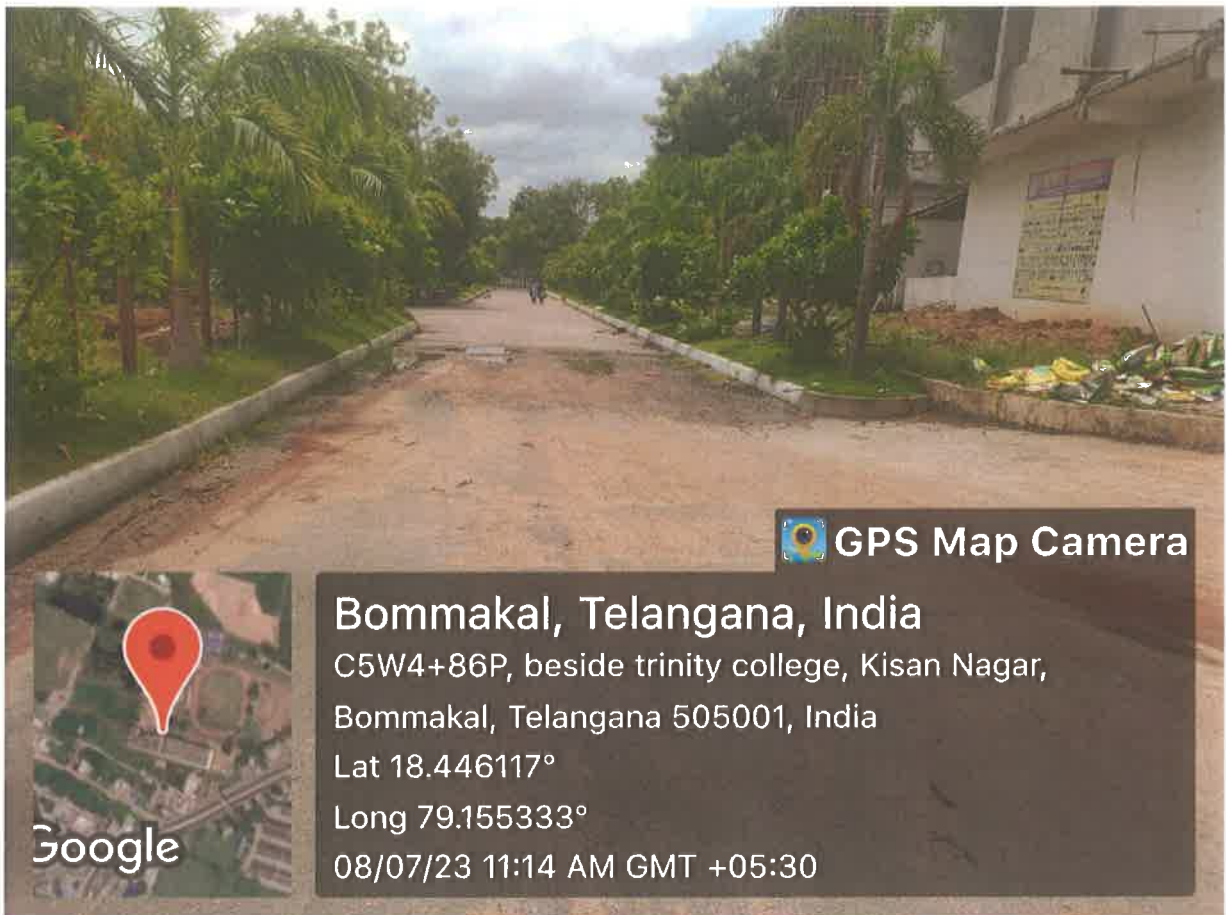

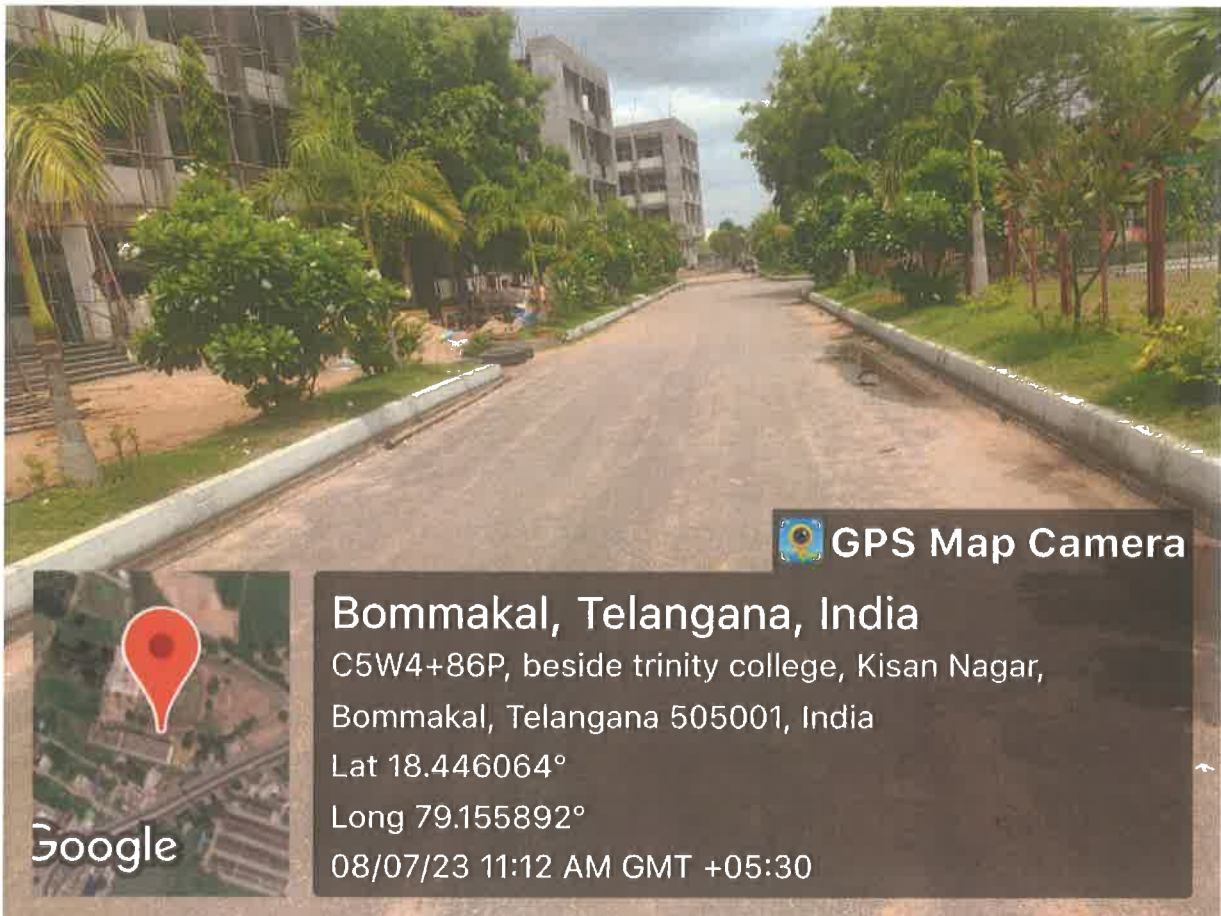

## 2. PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY PATHWAYS

Vehicle parking space is provided at the main entrance of the college campus. As the campus is vehicle free with some exceptions, students and staff experience comfort walking through the pedestrian friendly pathways. A pedestrian friendly pathway Campus has sufficient space for parking vehicles. Roads inside the campus are well maintained. Pedestrians can walk safely through the campus through walk friendly pathways. Entry of vehicles inside the campus is restricted. Security people are assigned duties on every turn and crossing to the campus. The campus has improved pedestrian visibility, additional area for pedestrian queuing, and a location for sidewalk amenities and landscaping. The internal roads are lined with trees and solar lights and they are properly maintained by the campus maintenance committee.





### 3. BAN ON USE OF PLASTIC

Single-use plastic items such as plastic bottles, bags, spoons, straws and cups are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through orientation and display boards in the premises. Ban on the use of plastics sustaining cleanliness is the essential part of healthy living because it is hygiene and helps us to develop our personality by keeping us clean externally and internally. To restrict the use of plastic, measures have been taken to replace plastic tea cups and glasses with steel glasses in the canteen. There are no paper cups, plastic plates and spoons instead of that we are using steel glasses, plates and spoons inside the campus. The staff and students are informed to use steel or copper water bottles instead of plastic bottles. Instead of plastics, reusable bags can be used which saves the environment and animals. Students also collected the plastics from the houses and surrounding areas and **“Say no to Plastics”**.





#### 4. LANDSCAPING WITH TREES AND PLANTS

Landscaping with Trees and Plants Within the campus, the institution maintains a clean and green environment, by establishing a distinct estate maintenance wing, the Institution ensures the preservation of the environment. It maintains the lawn and plantations by employing gardeners and sweepers. Our institution is more concerned with keeping a green campus and being environmentally friendly, which ensures that pure oxygen is available throughout the building.
